- 2014 Aston Martin Works restoration, 2022 Pebble Beach class win



- Supplied by Shelby American for display at the 1967 Geneva Motor Show
- Used as part of the prestigious Ford England Press Fleet around the UK and test driven by Graham Hill
- Period owners include first owner Anthony Bamford, Bruce Ropner and marque specialist John Etheridge
- Recently returned to original road specification, including wire wheels and factory colour of Blue Mink

1955 PORSCHE CARRERA SPEEDSTER 356 PRE-A

- One of only 8 'production' Carrera Speedsters, fitted with an ultra-rare high output Type 547/1 four cam engine
- Raced extensively at Californian SCCA events until the 1970s
- Placed in long term storage until 1991 when it was found with all its '079'-stamped original panels intact and rust free
- After a 2005 restoration, has participated in the Colorado Grand and Californian Mille as well as the GP Nuvolari in 2022









1931 BENTLEY 8 LITRE


- One of only 25 short chassis 8 Litre Bentleys produced, and the only surviving example still wearing the original Vanden Plas Silent Bloc Saloon Coachwork
- Ordered new by cigarette magnate J.A. Player as an owner-driver specification
- Sympathetically restored for the Bentley Centenary Rally and displayed at the 2019 Pebble Beach Concours d'Elegance
- Continuous well-documented history including long-term ownership from 1956–2018
- Matching numbers and highly original as confirmed in the accompanying Clare Hay report

1939 TALBOT LAGO T26 GS

- Built in 1939 as a monoplace centrale to race in the 1939 season, debuted with Raymond Mays
- Four successful post-war seasons with Louis Chiron including a 1948 win at the Grand Prix de l'ACF
- Recommissioned as a *biplace sport* in 1951 by the factory
- Four appearances at Le Mans including 2nd overall in 1951
- Previous owners include Jean-Pierre Bernard and Paul Bignon







1950 FERRARI 166/195 INTER BY VIGNALE

- Chassis 0051S, delivered new to Giovanni Vaccari as a Tipo 166 Vignale Coupe
- Quickly returned to factory and upgraded to a
 195 S specification 2340cc triple-carb V12
 Shortly thereafter converted by Vignale to Cabriolet and repainted dark blue, the only Spider ever produced
 Accompanied by a full Marcel Massini report

1954 HWM JAGUAR

- XPA 748 One of the initial three Jaguarengined sports racers produced by HWM
- Competed at the Prescott Hillclimb in 1954
- Superb restoration by marque expert Brazell Engineering
- Regular frontrunner, winner of the 2022 Woodcote Trophy at Silverstone









1962 JAGUAR E-TYPE

- (CUT 8)
 The last of the famous Protheroe-prepared Jaguars
- Raced by Ed Nelson in the 1966 season including at the Nürburgring and Mugello
- Campaigned by Nelson and Rhoddy Harvey Bailey until 1968
- Recent competition through the early 2000s including multiple Goodwood RACTT entries





GIL DE FERRAN AT THE MEWS





LM10, recently procured for a client, was one of 3 Aston Martins produced in 1932 and the team car that can claim the greatest individual contribution to building Aston Martin's successful pre-war racing record. In its first outing at Le Mans, LM10 secured 5th overall and first in class and would go on to finish in both the 1933 and 1934 editions of the race, making it the only Aston Martin to finish in 3 consecutive Le Mans and responsible for over 50% of the team's Le Mans finishes.

In the 1950s racing was still at the forefront of Aston Martin's identity and the DB3S was one of the most successful. DB3S/5 made her competition debut at the hands of Roy Salvadori as part of the 1,2,3, sweep at Silverstone in July 1954. Throughout 1955 she appeared in both British and international events including a notable win with Salvadori at Crystal Palace and an appearance in the XXII Mille Miglia. 1956 was perhaps her more famous season though, winning the Goodwood Easter Meeting at the hands of Stirling Moss in that iconic photograph. Further wins at Silverstone and Aintree, 2nd at Spa and 5th at the Nurburgring were the cherry on top of an illustrious season.

Congratulations to recent sales HWM1 and the Maserati A6GCS for also completing the event!










