

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
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LE MANS CLASSIC

Le Mans alumnus, the AC Cobra 39PH. returned for the first time since her 1963 24-hr class win. Whilst Gregor and Patrick Blakeney-Edwards were cognizant of her originality, an old warrior is still a warrior and 39PH battled hard for an excellent 9th overall! Gregor was reunited with his Porsche 996 GT3 RSR which, in period, was sponsored by Fiskens and raced by Gregor, Ian Donaldson and Lars-Erik Nielsen to 6th in class and 18th overall at the 2004 Le Mans 24hr. Christoff made his Le Mans debut in the Pre-63 E-Type and took to it like a duck to water. We can't wait for the 100th Anniversary celebrations next year!

Gregor and Christoff had a great deal of success on the hill in AOA 2 -Christoff came first in the Handicap and Gregor broke the record for Vauxhall 30/98 times with a 49.6s, smashing the long-held fastest time of 50 seconds!

Felix Goddard kindly offered Christoff a seat in his Cooper Bobtail and the pair raced into the sunset finishing an impressive 7th in the Freddie March Trophy. On Sunday, Christoff drove the ex-Sebring MGB (featured earlier) to 17th in the packed-grid Lavant Cup!


