



### 1921 GRAND PRIX SUNBEAM

- One of the most important British racing cars of all time
- 5th average speed at the 1921 Indianapolis 500 miles with Ora Haibe
- Raced by Hero Sir Henry Segrave at the 1921 French Grand Prix - Le Mans (9th), 1921 Brooklands 250 miles (1st avg speed) and at the 1922 Isle of Man T.T. (fastest lap)
- Astonishingly original thanks to stints in two major UK collections, offered from a private collection after 35 years









### 1961 PORSCHE CARRERA GT

- Rare factory 4-cam Carrera GT delivered with Fuhrmann 4-cam engine
- Sole known RHD example surviving of 3 built
- Period history 3rd at Macau GP, recent competition at 2021 Goodwood Revival
- Initial restoration by Tiziano Serratini and Arno Reinbacher
- Race engine and substantial recent works by Prill Porsche Classics






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# BUGATH TYPE 35

- Continuous history, rewarding project of the highest calibre









### **2008 AUDI A4 DTM**

- Driven by Tom Kristensen as part of the Audi factory team in the 2008 DTM series, Fastest lap at Zandvoort and Catalunya and pole at Nürburgring and Le Mans Bugatti Track
- Raced as part of Team Rosberg in the 2011 DTM Series by Edoardo Mortara, 3rd at Brands Hatch and at Oschersleben
- A competitive entry for the DTM Classic Cup Series
- Offered from a legendary collection of important race cars



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
### 1989 PEUGEOT 205 T16

- One of 200 built to homologate the T16 model which would go on to be the most successful car to compete in the last two years of the WRC's Group B era winning the 1985 and 1986 Constructor's and Drivers' titles
- A sparingly used example showing only 12,000kms
- Returned to the UK in 2022 after forming part of a renowned Dutch collection
- Currently holds both UK and EU registrations









### 1964 LOTUS CORTINA

- The 1964 British Saloon Car Championship winner, driven by the legendary Jim Clark
- Three outright victories and eight class wins in this works car claimed the touring car championship for Lotus, Ford and Clark
- First registered to Lotus Cars Ltd, later with Tom Walkinshaw collection and Cortina racer Kerry Michael
- Offered in outstanding order fresh from appearances in two Goodwood parades






### 1932 ALFA ROMEO 8C SHORT CHASSIS FIGONI SPIDER


